BURLCO HEALTH DEPT. TO HOLD 3 MORE FLU CLINICS **January 18th, 20th & 25th Added for County Residents**

The Burlington County Health Department will hold three additional flu vaccination clinics, open to all county residents, on January 18, 20 and 25th, respectively, Freeholder Dawn Marie Addiego announced.

Clinics at the Raphael Meadow Health Center off Woodlane Road in Westampton will be held on consecutive Fridays, Jan. 18th and Jan. 25th from 1 to 5 p.m. for residents age 18 or over, or chronically ill residents age 13 or over with a physician's permission note.

Another clinic has been added for Sunday, Jan. 20th from 11 a.m.-1 p.m. at Gwenwava Khalsa Darwar of South Jersey, Inc, 1240 Old York Road in Burlington Township. Again, residents need to be age 18 or over, or chronically ill residents age 13 or over with a physician's permission note.

County Public Health Coordinator Robert Gogats said vaccination in January and February can still offer protection against influenza this season. The County held 22 clinics for the elderly and chronically ill in November and December, and one on Jan. 11, 2008.
